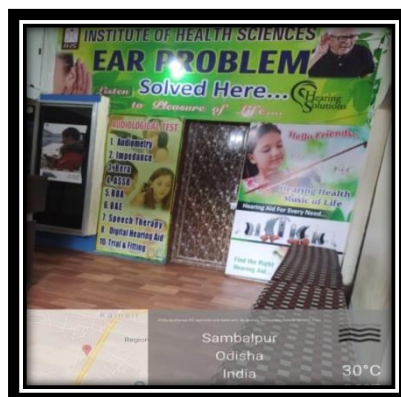
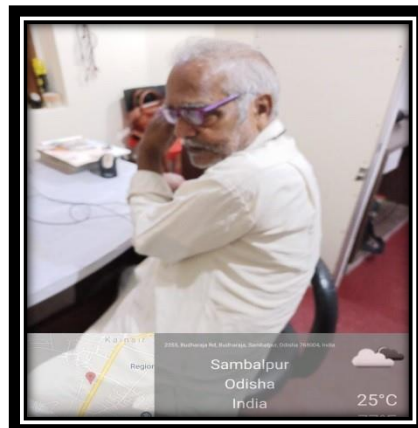


4.2.4 Satellite Health Center for students training

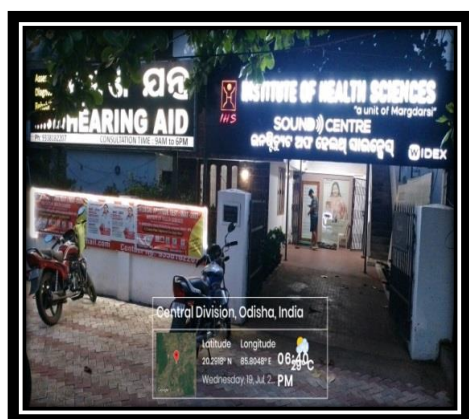
